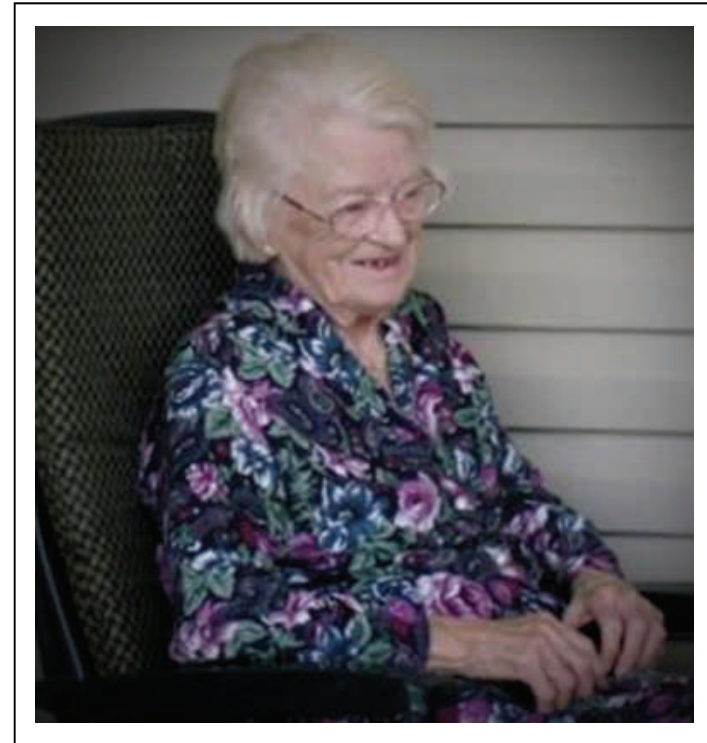


*I had an angel here beside me,
