a time to break down, and a time to build up;*

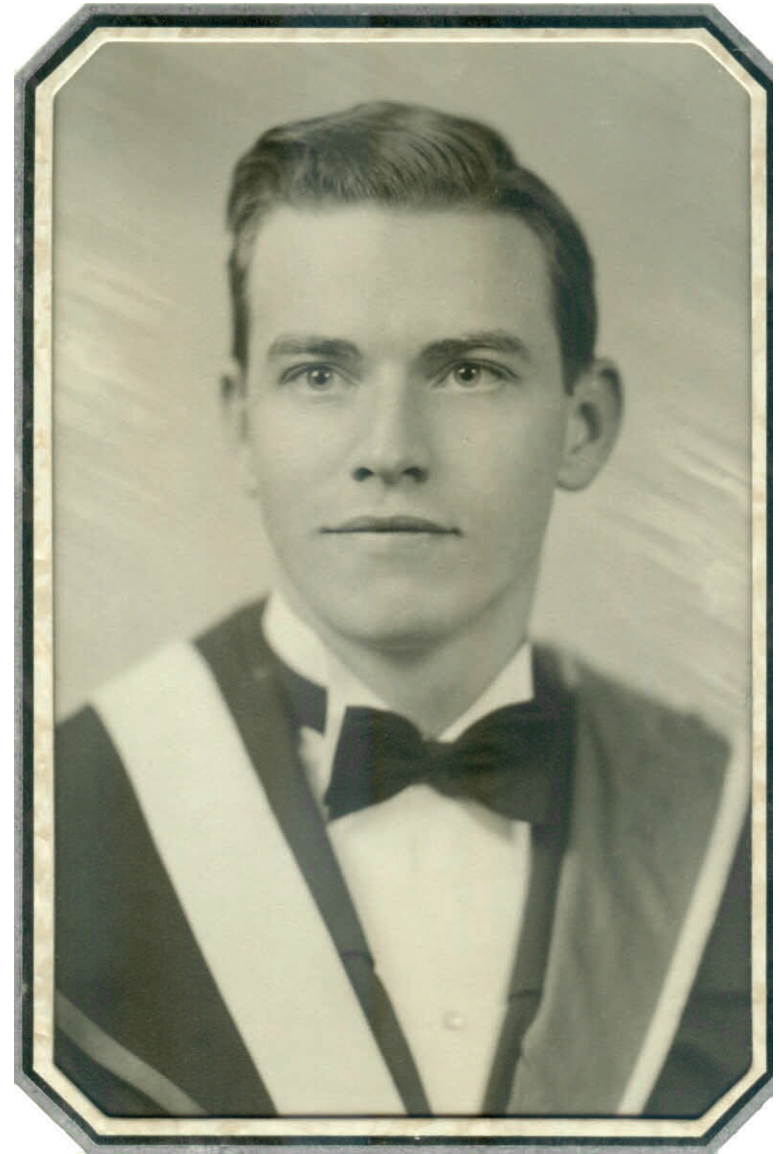
*A time to weep, and a time to laugh;
